CODE OF CONDUCT – FOR MANAGER / FOOTBALL COACH

In accordance with the Football Association code of conduct the following code should be adhered to at all times:

1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of each and every person and treat equally within the context of the sport.
2. Place the well-being and safety of each player above all other considerations, including the development of performance.
3. Adhere to all guidelines laid down within the constitution and the rules of the Football Association.
4. Develop an appropriate supportive relationship with each player based on mutual trust and respect.
5. Not exert undue influence to obtain personal benefit or reward.
6. Encourage and guide players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance.
7. Ensure that the activities they direct or advocate are appropriate for the age, maturity, experience and ability of players.
8. Should at the outset clarify with the player (and where appropriate with the parent), exactly what is expected of them and also what they are entitled to expect from their coach.
9. Co-operate fully with specialists (e.g. other coaches, officials, sports, scientists, doctors, physiotherapists) in the best interests of the player.
10. Always promote the appropriate code of conduct and positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play) to players, parents and spectators alike. Never condone violations of the laws of the game, behaviour contrary to the spirit of the laws of the game or relevant rules and regulations or the use of prohibited substances or techniques.
11. Must consistently display high standards of behaviour and experience and be a role model for players, parents and spectators
