CODE OF CONDUCT – FOR PLAYERS

In accordance with the Football Association code of conduct the following code should be adhered to at all times:

1. Play because you enjoy football, not to please your parents or coach.
2. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of each and every person and treat equally within the context of the sport.
3. Adhere to all guidelines laid down by the constitution and the code of conduct by the club.
4. Develop an appropriate working relationship with the coach based on mutual trust and respect.
5. Accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance, and do not argue with the referee or assistant referee.
6. Should, at the outset, clarify with the coach (and, where appropriate, their parents) exactly what is expected of them and also what they are entitled to expect from players.
7. Co-operate fully with specialists (e.g. other coaches, officials, sports, scientists, doctors, physiotherapists) in their own interest.
8. Always adhere to the positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play) and never condone violations of the laws of the game, behaviour contrary to the spirit of the laws of the game or relevant rules and regulations or the use of prohibited substances or techniques.
9. Consistently display high standards of behaviour including not using foul and abusive language.
10. Appreciate the importance of striving to win, not winning itself.
